### CANN NEWSLETTER



The Center for Neurorestoration and Neurotechnology (CfNN) began with a June 2012 funding award of \$900,000 per year for 5 years from the Department of Veterans Affairs Rehabilitation Research and Development Service. The Center is a collaboration between the Providence VA Medical Center, Brown University, Butler Hospital, Lifespan, and Massachusetts General Hospital.

### Presentation of Research Results

Presentation of Research Results. The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) has revised the Handbook that establishes the procedures, assigns responsibilities and specifies authority for ensuring that the contributions of the Department of Veterans Affairs to research are appropriately acknowledged and publicly disclosed. Major changes include: 1) removed the requirements that VA affiliation must be named first as this is often not possible when there are multiple authors; 2) Added information to describe the Public Access requirement for Office of Research and Development (ORD)-supported peerreviewed publications; and 3) Eliminated responsibilities of the Medical Center Director, Associate Chief of Staff for Research, and the Research and Development Committee.

All publications, manuscripts, abstracts, and other presentations should be presented to the Research & Development (R&D) Committee for approval. In addition, all ORD field investigators are required to upload notifications about upcoming publications, presentations, media interviews, and other professional activities to Pub Tracker. Contact Candace Shuman for guidance.

A list of publications from each PI for the current FY needs to be sent to Nancy Gilbride. These are needed for the Annual Report and will also be highlighted in the CfNN Newsletter.
