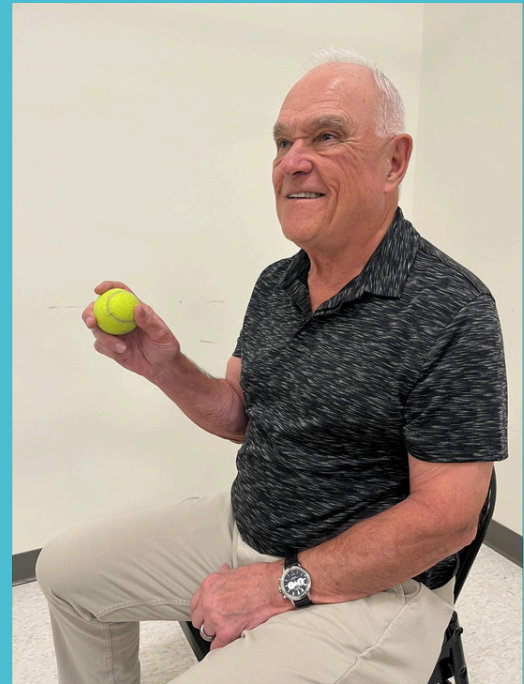




800,000 Americans will experience a stroke every year.
80% will have long-lasting weakness in their hand and arm.

If you have had a **stroke**, you may be eligible for a research study.



You may be eligible if you:

- Had a stroke more than 6 months ago
- Have hand or arm weakness after a stroke

Participants can expect to:

- Complete approximately 13 hours, including breaks, of testing over 1-3 visits at the Providence VA Medical Center
- Answer questions about your stroke and rehabilitation history
- Undergo various tests of arm and hand function
- Receive an MRI and Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS) if you are eligible

Be part of a team of volunteers to help learn more about how individuals recover hand and arm function after stroke.

Participation in research is voluntary. Compensation will be provided after research visit completion. Transportation to and from your visits may be available.
