

15,000 Veterans will experience a stroke every year.

80% will have long-lasting weakness in their hand and arm.

If you have had a stroke, you may be eligible for a research study.



You may be eligible if you:

- Had a stroke more than 6 months ago
- Have hand or arm weakness after a stroke
- Are able to get an MRI
- Do not have a history of seizures

Participants can expect to:

- Complete 8-9 hours of testing over 2-3 visits at the Providence VA Medical Center
- Answer questions about your stroke and rehabilitation history
- Undergo various tests of arm and hand function
- Receive an MRI and Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS)

Volunteer for a research study to help learn more about how Veterans have recovered hand and arm function after stroke. Knowledge gained from this study will be used to one day help develop better rehabilitation treatments for stroke survivors.

Participation in research is voluntary. Compensation will be provided after research visit completion. Transportation to and from your visits may be available. Contact:
