

Who are we inviting?

We are looking for men and women who:

- Have unilateral upper limb loss or limb difference at the transradial or transhumeral level;
- Currently use a body powered, myoelectric and/or hybrid prosthesis, that is in good working order; and
- Can use their device for testing purposes for approximately 3 hours (with time for resting).
- *You do not need to be a Veteran to participate

What is the Purpose of the Study?

The purpose of this study is to help us understand benefits and drawbacks of currently available prosthetic devices.



What is Involved if I Participate?

If you are interested and eligible for the study, you will be asked to come to the nearest participating data collection site and take part in surveys and tests to assess how you function with your prosthesis. All of the information obtained through your participation will be kept completely confidential and will be used for research purposes only.
